HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY HIGHLIGHTS

- Purpose: Protect lives and enhance health of all underground coal mining personnel.
- Scope: Applies to all employees, contractors, and supporting staff across all mining leases.
- Organizational Structure: Includes General Manager H&S, Deputy GM H&S, Mining Managers, Mine Sirdars, and a 33-member safety team.
- Objectives:
- Conduct daily pre-work mine inspections; commence work only after clearance.
- Enforce use of personal protective equipment (PPE).
- Identify and report occupational hazards promptly.
- Monitor mining operations to prevent diseases and hazards.
- Provide rapid emergency response and medical care.
- Promote safety awareness, clear communication, and eliminate language barriers.
- Comply with provincial, national, and international mine safety regulations.
- Implementation Procedures:
- Develop and update Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) communicated in local languages.
- Maintain detailed records of inspections and incidents.
- Suspend work for necessary repairs to ensure safety.
- Hold regular safety meetings biweekly internally, monthly with contractors.
- Investigate all incidents thoroughly and apply corrective actions.
- Ensure strong roof and ground support systems.
- Conduct pre-employment and periodic medical examinations (lung function, X-rays, hearing, vision, etc.).
- Conduct safety awareness sessions using audiovisual aids.
- Identify risks through Job Safety Analysis (JSA) and apply control measures.
- Maintain effective ventilation; monitor harmful gas levels with detectors and alarms.
- Ensure machinery and electrical safety with pre-use inspections and operator training.
- Prevent occupational diseases by controlling dust and gas exposure.
- Medical Facilities:
- Fully equipped first aid stations and 24/7 onsite dispensaries with qualified medical staff.
- Ambulance services and referral protocols for emergencies.
- Mental Health & Welfare:
- Provide counseling, encourage recreational activities, enforce rest breaks, and support hygiene and nutrition.

- Offer clean drinking water and sanitary facilities.
- Health Awareness & Vaccination:
- Regular education on smoking cessation, substance abuse prevention, respiratory health, and hygiene.
- Facilitate immunizations (Tetanus, Hepatitis B, COVID-19 as applicable).
- Rescue Operations:
- Preparedness with trained teams, emergency equipment (gas detectors, PPE, hoisting systems, fire extinguishers, ventilation, dewatering pumps).
- Maintain calm, clear communication, and efficient resource use during emergencies.
- Emergency medical training in first aid and CPR, with 24/7 response capability.
- Compliance and Ethics:
- Personal health information managed confidentially per labor laws.
- Review and Continuous Improvement:
- Annual policy reviews or after major incidents, legal changes, or committee recommendations.
